

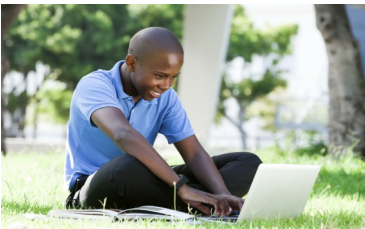


SUMMER BRIDGE & PATHWAYS

- Mathematics for students entering grades 6,7,8

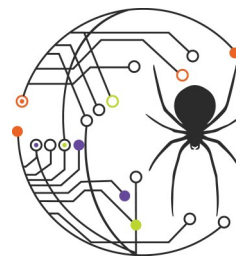
SUMMER PATHWAYS— VIRTUAL SUMMER CAMP For students entering grades 6,7,8
